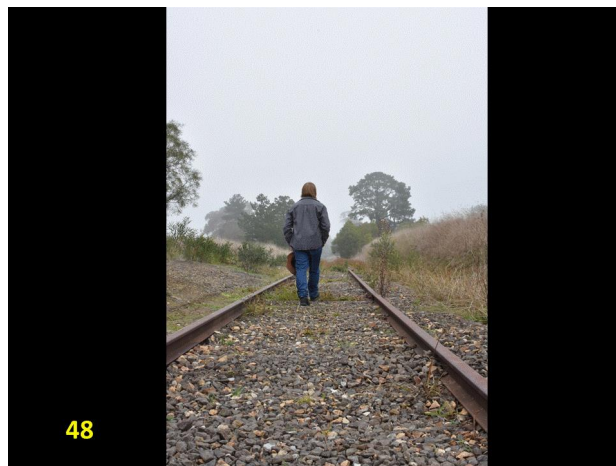
Second prize (18 and over) is by Rose Sherriff of “Bill on Anzac Day”



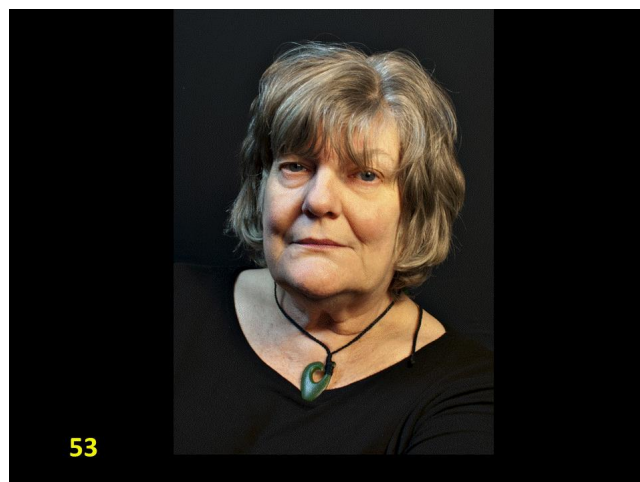
The **First prize (17 and under)** is awarded to Indiana Greer: “Sibling”
